K-9 Fly-Boat-n-Rope..... (courses)
Each course carries an endorsement for your
K-9 Log book and a Speciality Certificate



Fly:

- . Marking a suitable LZ /Marshalling signals to helicopter pilots and all safety and harnessing drills.
- Boarding drills and Short flight—Land and deploy to search task exercise.

Boat

Outline:

- Basic instruction to handlers on entering and leaving RIB's with K9
- · Basic Instruction on Boat to Boat transfer with K9
- Basic instruction on entering and leaving larger vessels and associated risk with K9

Purpose:

- · Customs type of searches of boats
- Able to transfer from tender to larger vessels

By the end of this unit individuals will be able to demonstrate they have learnt the following:

- · How to board with a search dog a RIB
- · How to board with a search dog to other vessels
- · How to transfer between a tender and a larger vessel with dog
- · The safety factors and risks of boat work
- · The layout and consideration of searching boats/large vessels

Method of training (sample of a previous program)

- Class room based PPT and discussions to cover health and safety and boat layouts and cover theory of what will happen during exercises (4hours)
- . Practical session likely to be carried out at Fleetwood Nautical training centre (8hours)
- . Use of workbook and practical observation to form assessment
- . Λ Live Test Exercise example crossing ie: between Heysham and Isle of man
- . Example program & Suggested timings:
 - o Friday assemble at 16:00 at Heysham cargo terminal
 - Basic H+S and intros
 - o Board Ro-Ro 18:00
 - Test crossing desensitising dog and handlers to sea environment/sickness etc
 - Search exercise at sea arrive at Douglas port approx. 03:00
 - o Stand down 03:00 05:00
 - Return crossing more search exercises
 - Arrive Heysham 10:00
 - o Travel to Fleetwood and stand down time till 18:00
 - Search for missing person and PPT theories
 - Finish Saturday 20:00
 - Sunday RIB trips and training
 - o Each RIB can carry 1 driver, 2medic/diver support staff, max 3 handlers
 - o Doing RIB to RIB and M.O.B drills

Way forward De-brief and feedbacks for Major Inter-operability future training. log books signed and course certificates issued, group dispersal







Helicopter Flight:

Outline:

- Basic instruction to handlers entering and leaving a helicopter
- De-sensitising dogs to noise and sensation of flight
 (How to assist landing/Take of helicopter How to approach helicopter non tactical form up).

Purpose:

To prepare dogs and handlers to be deployable by air

By the end of the course individuals will be able to demonstrate they have learnt the following:

- Enter and leave a helicopter safely
- Clear and prep site for landing
- Secure dog for flight
- Control dog in flight

Method of training

- Class room based PPT and discussions to cover health and safety theory (2hours)
- Practical session (4hours)
- Use of workbook and practical observation to form K9 log book assessment

This first pilot course will be subject to Demand /Numbers/AvailabilityIt is designed to enable us to further develop the content and is already a minimum entry level standard for ALL DESA Gold level (4) K9 Search Handlers. But it is a dynamic content and further input from Government and key stakeholders will decide the future of these log book endorsements and optional units for those awards.
